This Certificate (KuttMatsvinn-beviset) has been achieved by the company DRYTECH by joining the Industry Agreement on the Reduction of Food Waste and reporting their food waste data and implemented measures for the previous year. The company also supports Matvett's voluntary funding model* as an important source of financing effort to reduce food waste in the industry.

Elements that strengthen both the industry's and the company's food waste work:


The Industry Agreement is a long-term agreement with the aim of halving food waste by 2030. The purpose of the agreement is to ensure that companies follow the goals set in the agreement by implementing systematic work to prevent and reduce food waste in their own operations and in other parts of the value chain, including the consumer level. Increased collaboration between actors in the food industry is necessary to develop new solutions for reduced food waste together.

By joining the Industry Agreement, DRYTECH actively works with the following:

- Measuring and reporting of their amount of food waste and implemented measures annually to Matvett via a data collecting company
- Mapping and evaluating the causes of food waste and defining reduction targets
- Ensure training of employees in measuring and implementing waste reducing measures. Appoint a person responsible for food waste where appropriate.
- Identifying and implementing measures and plans within various parts of the value chain that together contribute to achieve the reduction targets
- Have an agreement in place with a Food Bank or non-profit organization for donation of surplus food
- Identifying and implementing targeted measures to raise awareness and contribute to reducing food waste among consumers
- Making resources available to participate in various industry projects with the aim of reducing food waste in the value chain
- Actively participate in Matvett's digital campaigns and showcase own food waste initiatives where relevant
- Sharing knowledge and experiences within the industry
- Familiarize with the "10 principles for increased collaboration"

Based on this, DRYTECH is well positioned to work systematically and effectively in reducing food waste both within its own operations and in collaboration with other actors across the value chain, including consumers.
